Concept Note: Faculty Development Programme

The growth and development of a variety of "sciences" have spurted new domains that percolated across conventional disciplinary boundaries reconfiguring their landscape and politics. Strikingly, cognitive and evolutionary sciences as well big-data and method-driven approaches stake out new claims to understand society. As a result, social sciences have come under increasing pressure to reorient themselves and undertake a critical inquiry into the epistemologies and practices, their institutionalisation, and methods.
