2 Credit course 30 hrs

This course is a UGC-mandated compulsory course for research scholars.

Overview:

This course is intended to be an introduction to the philosophy underpinning scientific research and the ethics of scientific communication. Along with a theoretical understanding of various aspects of the scientific enterprise, topics of practical interest will also be covered.

Outcomes:

After successful completion of the course, learners will be equipped to understand and deal will ethical issues arising from scientific research, effectively communicate research findings in appropriate fora, and use matrices for measuring scientific impact in a responsible manner.

Pedagogy:

Online classroom sessions will be supplemented with hands-on training. Formative and summative assessment of learning outcomes will take the form of quizzes, assignments and mid- and end-semester examinations.
