The Central Library at the National Institute of Technology Warangal, established along with the Institute's inception, is located adjacent to the administrative block. The library is housed with a plinth area of 4000 Sq. Mtrs (Ground + 2 floors). The services and operations in the Central Library are fully computerized. The database of entire Library acquisitions was created using Koha software. Being an integral part of academic and research work on the campus, it provides library and information services to support the teaching, learning and research activities of the Institute by creating state-of-the-art facilities and offering innovative services. The library has a fast-growing collection of books, journals, magazines both in print and digital format. - All submissions must be electronic in MS Word format, using the template. Once your manuscript is ready to be submitted, please log into the Easy Chair for IIC 2022,
- Corresponding authors should sign the Copyright License Agreement and email the agreement in PDF format to illissic2022@gmail.com
- At least one of the authors must register for the conference before 15-08-2022 for the inclusion of the paper in the conference proceedings.
