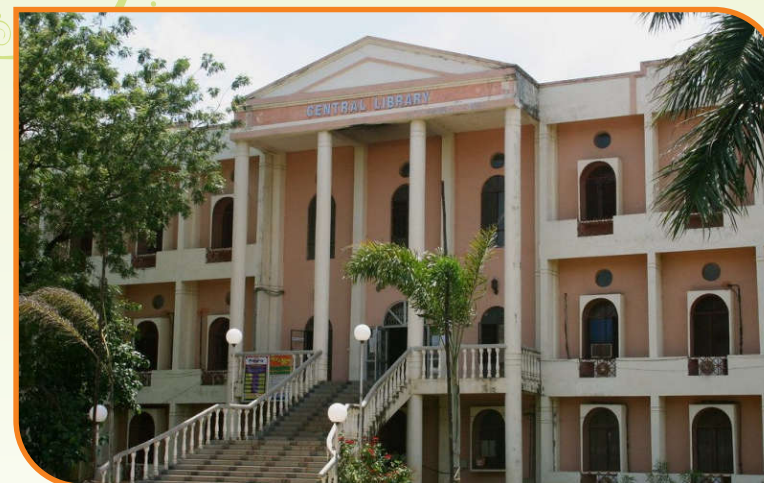

About the conference

The 5th International Conference on "Revitalizing the Libraries to the Android Society" (IIC 2022) is organized by Central Library, National Institute of Technology (NIT) Warangal, Telangana with I-LISS (formerly LISSASPAC). Libraries are vital for getting access to information and become defacto providers of basic digital literacy training – such as how to use an iPad or android mobile technology. Libraries have deliberately sought to change perceptions of themselves from spaces of collection to spaces of creation. The behaviour of library users has drastically changed in recent years. Libraries and librarians play a central role in organising and communicating knowledge. They are an important part of the knowledge production and use chain. With the liberalisation and reform of the telecom sector, the people across the globe started to enjoy an affordable internet. Revitalizing the library is one of the pressing issues that has to be accomplished in the existing Android society. Keeping those in mind the organisers have planned three-day international conference on "Revitalising the Libraries to the Android Society". This conference provides a platform to all stake holders in the field of libraries and information profession and aims to promote innovation and augmentation, utilization of modern technologies in the direction of reaching Android society. The conference will be held in Central Library, National Institute of Technology (NIT) Warangal, Telangana, India, during October 13-14, 2022.

About NIT Warangal

National Institute of Technology Warangal, formerly known as Regional Engineering College was established in 1959. Over the years it has developed into a premier institute of higher learning and is ranked among the top technical education institutions in India. There are 14 Departments offering 8 undergraduate and 31 post-graduate besides doctoral programs. About 5000 students across the country and about 500 international students study on the campus. It is a fully residential campus sprawling over 250 acres with excellent infrastructure in the form of a state-of-the-art library, seminar halls, guest houses, and laboratories.

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About Central Library, NITW

The Central Library at the National Institute of Technology Warangal, established along with the Institute's inception, is located adjacent to the administrative block. The library is housed with a plinth area of 4000 Sq. Mtrs (Ground + 2 floors). The services and operations in the Central Library are fully computerized. The database of entire Library acquisitions was created using Koha software. Being an integral part of academic and research work on the campus, it provides library and information services to support the teaching, learning and research activities of the Institute by creating state-of-the-art facilities and offering innovative services. The library has a fast-growing collection of books, journals, magazines both in print and digital format. Most of the in-house services of the library are fully computerized and provide access to many core subscribed online and open access resources.

About Warangal

Warangal is the second largest city of the new state of Telangana. It is situated at a distance of 140 km from the state capital Hyderabad (Nearest Airport). It is well connected by Rail (Kazipet Junction is two km away and Warangal Station is 12 km away) and by Road (NH 202). Warangal is renowned for its rich historical and cultural heritage. It was the seat of erstwhile Kakatiya dynasty. It is a seat of tourist attractions with a number of historical monuments like Thousand Pillars Temple, Warangal Fort, Bhadrakali Temple, Ramappa Temple and Laknavaram Lake located in a radius of 30 km.

About I-LISS

International Library and Information Science Society (formerly Library and Information Science Society for Asia and Pacific) is a non-profit organization representing the interest of Library and Information science professionals and library users. This society was started in the year 2015 at SRM University, ICIDL 2015 International conference where representatives from 11 Nations, such as South Korea, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Iran, USA, Nepal, India and China were founding members of this society. Subsequently in the year 2019, LISSASAP (Library and Information Science Society for Asia and the Pacific) has been renamed as International Library and Information Science Society (**I-LISS**), where the member countries have grown to 17 including the founding nations. The society has been registered under the Tamil Nadu Societies Regulation Act, 1975 (Tamil Nadu Act 27 of 1975). Reg.No.44/2016 on 13th May 2016. The following are the objectives of the I-LISS:

- To contribute for the betterment of Library and Information Science Profession and Education, Training and Research and to facilitate the cooperation and collaboration among the researchers in all areas related to Library and Information Science, mainly based on the close personal relationships and co-operation
- To promote the best practices in Library and Information Science among the members and member countries
- To conduct Conferences, Seminars and workshops in Library and Information Science.
- To publish journals, newsletters and research monographs for the benefit of the members of the Society in tune with the objectives of the Society. To do all such other things as incidental or conducive to the fulfilment of the above mentioned aims and objectives

Call for papers

Papers are invited on the theme based on research experience or theoretical model, case studies from all fraternities, including LIS students, librarians, academicians, research scholars and IT professionals. The paper must be application oriented addressing the present day issues and providing solutions are most welcome.

Contributors are asked to submit an extended abstract in minimum of 1000 words before the time schedule mentioned in the portal. The decision of editorial committee is final in the selection of abstract. Once the abstract is accepted the decision will be intimated to authors to submit full length paper and registration fee. Without registration fee paper will not be accepted for print the conference proceeding.

Guide line for Authors

- The page limit for full papers is 6-8 pages in length, approximately 4,000-6,000 words (excluding references).
- The papers should present new and original research results from empirical investigations, or from theory and model development
- All submissions must include title, author lists and affiliation, short abstract (no more than 200 words, one paragraph only), keywords, introduction, body of text, conclusion, acknowledgment (if necessary), and references
- All submissions must be electronic in MS Word format, using the template. Once your manuscript is ready to be submitted, please log into the Easy Chair for IIC 2022,
- Corresponding authors should sign the Copyright License Agreement and email the agreement in PDF format to **ilissic2022@gmail.com**
- At least one of the authors must register for the conference before **15-08-2022** for the inclusion of the paper in the conference proceedings.
